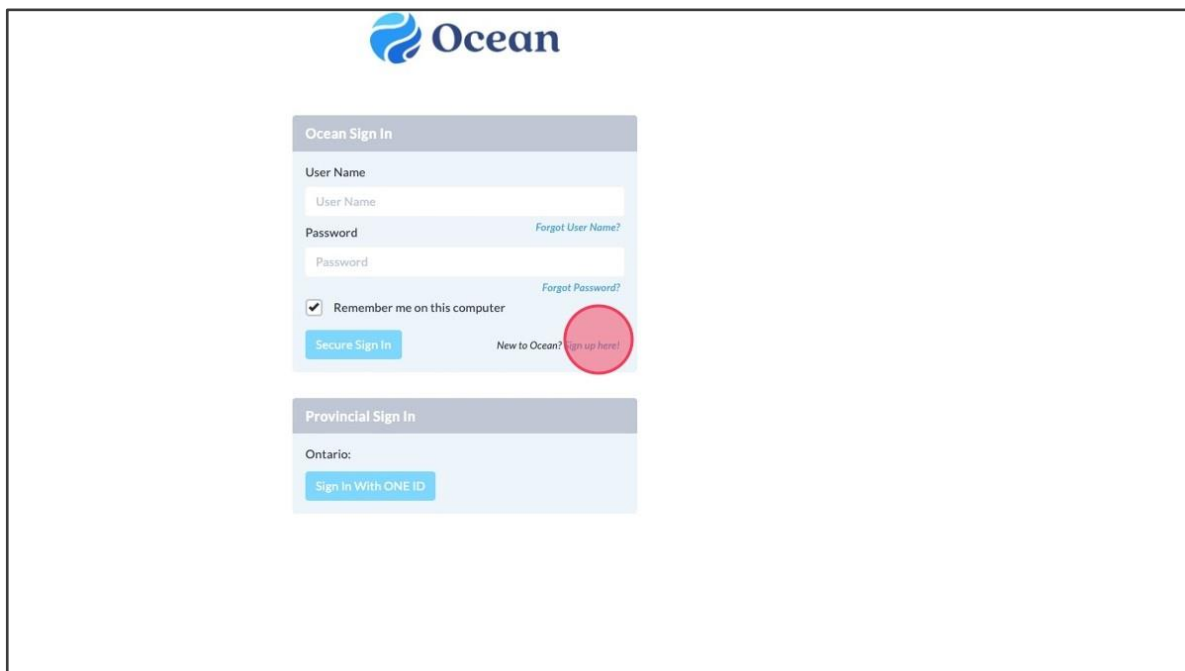


# Create a user account in the Ocean Portal

This guide walks you through how to create a new user account in the Ocean Portal and agree to the End User License Agreement (EULA).

## Step 1: Start the account creation process

1. Go to <https://ocean.cognisantmd.com/> in your web browser.
2. Click the **Sign up here!** button in the bottom right corner of the sign-in box.
